

## **BOMB THREAT GUIDE**

IF A	A BOMB THREAT IS RECEIVED BY PHONE							
In r	esponse to a bomb threat, employees should consider the following actions:							
	Be calm, courteous, and do not interrupt the caller.							
	Keep the caller on the phone as long as possible and do not hang up.							
	Signal to someone near you to alert a supervisor.							
	Write down everything the caller tells you.							
	Ask the caller as many questions as possible. Refer to page 2, the <i>Bomb Threat Phone Record form</i> , to record any impressions from the call (tone of voice, background noise).							
	Immediately notify UT Police of the bomb threat by dialing 713-792-2890 or call 911.							
IF A	A BOMB THREAT IS RECEIVED BY EMAIL							
	Immediately notify UT Police of the bomb threat by dialing 713-792-2890 or call 911.							
	Print a copy of the email for UT Police.							
	Do not forward the message.							
	Do not delete the message.							
IF A	A BOMB THREAT IS RECEIVED BY WRITTEN NOTE							
	Immediately notify UT Police of the bomb threat by dialing 713-792-2890 or call 911.							
	If possible, do not touch the note. Handle the note as minimally as possible and do not discard the note.							
IF A	A BOMB IS SEEN/RECEIVED ON CAMPUS							
	If you find a device or suspicious package, DO NOT move or touch the device or package. If possible, alert others in your area, immediately secure your area, retreat and leave the area to a safe location, and notify UT Police of its location and description.							
	Immediately notify UT Police of the bomb threat by dialing 713-792-2890 or call 911.							
IF A	AN EVACUATION IS ACTIVATED BY EMERGENCY RESPONSE PERSONNEL							
	Await instructions from authorities.							
	If an evacuation is activated by emergency response personnel, remove patients, visitors and employees from immediate danger as instructed by UT Police to designated areas.							
	<ul> <li>When evacuating patients, ensure the following are accounted for:</li> <li>Tracking records</li> <li>Medical records</li> <li>Family and visitors</li> </ul>
